



Luke in his Gospel included narratives and sayings that were not in any other gospel, such as The Prodigal Son and the Good Samaritan.

As a first century historian, Luke investigated everything about Jesus and tried to communicate the truth about Jesus to the community, drawing on oral and written sources. Most importantly, Luke interpreted, in his own way, the significance of Jesus; as was expected of historians at that time.

Mary sets out to visit her relative Elizabeth, who lived in a hill town in Judea, an area which extended from Emmaus in the West to the Jordan River in the East and surrounded Jerusalem.

Elizabeth is the mother-to-be of John the Baptist and the wife of Zechariah. She is also a relative of Mary. She was barren (unable to conceive) and of an older age when it was announced that she would give birth to a son named John, along with the prophetic message about John's future mission. It is this barrenness that foretold of a child of great significance, like that of Sarah (mother of Isaac) and Hannah (mother of Samuel) in the Old Testament. Elizabeth also felt that her pregnancy signalled that the Lord had found favour with her. Mary learned of Elizabeth's pregnancy through the angel Gabriel and went to visit her.
