ASH WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 26

The day of abstinence & fasting

What is forbidden and allowed to be eaten?

The law of abstinence: this refers to abstaining from meat; forbids the use of meat. This does not apply to dairy products, eggs, or condiments and shortening made from animal fat.

The law of fasting: this refers to the quantity of food taken, thus also refraining from eating between meals; allows only one full meal a day and two smaller meals (snacks). The two smaller meals should not equal the quantity of the main meal (which in the United States is customarily observed as the evening dinner).

When fasting, eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed, including milk and fruit juices.

On fast days, fish and all cold-blooded animals may be eaten (e.g., clams, turtles, etc.).
