ST. ANTHONY THE GREAT

Memorial is celebrated on the day of his death, January 17. He was born in Egypt in the 3rd century AD, at the age of twenty renounced everything to live as a hermit until IO6 years of age. Though he belonged to a rather wealthy family, from an early age he showed little interest in the flattery and luxury of worldly life: to parties and banquets he preferred work and meditation, and on the death of his parents he distributed all his wealth to the poor. He chose to live as a hermit and retired into solitude, to work and pray, at first near his hometown and later in the desert. Here he spent many years living in an ancient rockhewn tomb, struggling against the temptations of the devil, who often appeared to him to show what he could have done if he had remained in the world. Sometimes the devil appeared as a ferocious beast - often as a pig - in order to frighten him, but to these temptations Anthony responded with fasting and penance of any kind, always managing to triumph.

His reputation as a hermit soon spread among the faithful and Anthony, who wanted to live totally detached from the rest of the world, was repeatedly forced to change his place of "residence" to escape the crowds of people who flocked to him from all over to get his advice and see him. Around 311 he went to Alexandria to give aid to the Christians persecuted by Emperor Maximian, and then retired to the Qolzoum Mountain along the Red Sea, but had to return to Alexandria shortly after to fight the Arian heresy.


