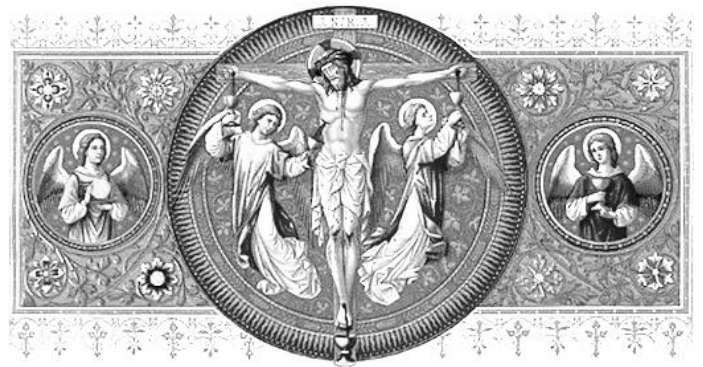

THE CATECHISM CORNER

220. When does the first commandment forbid the making or the use of statues and pictures?

The first commandment forbids the making or the use of statues and pictures only when they promote false worship. *Thou shalt not have strange Gods before me. Thou shalt not make to thyself a graven thing, nor the likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or in the earth beneath, nor of those things that are in the waters under the earth. (Exodus 20:3-4)*

221. Is it right to show respect to the statues and pictures of Christ and of the saints?

It is right to show respect to the statues and pictures of Christ and of the saints, just as it is right to show respect to the images of those whom we honor or love on earth.

222. Do we honor Christ and the saints when we pray before the crucifix, relics, and sacred images?

We honor Christ and the saints when we pray before the crucifix, relics, and sacred images because we honor the persons they represent; we adore Christ and venerate the saints.

Summer Dress Code In the Church

Everybody is welcome despite their clothing. Respect for the Lord & His Church calls for the proper dress code.

Man and boys coming to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass shall come dressed properly. Garments that are overly casual sleeveless, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative are not considered appropriate. Shorts should reach the knees.

Women and girls shall come reverently and modestly dressed in skirts, dresses, loose fitting and appropriate pants suits or similar attire. Apparel worn by women and girls must not be overly casual, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative. Inappropriate dress, even though modest, should be avoided. For example, garish beachwear may be modest but is inappropriate at Mass. **Flip-flops** (of any kind) are another example of inappropriate dress.
