THE CATECHISM ALSO HIGHLIGHTS THE NEED TO SHOW OUTWARDLY WHAT WE UNDERSTAND INWARDLY, ABOUT EXACTLY WHAT IS HAPPENING AT MASS. "BODILY DEMEANOR (GESTURES, CLOTHING, ATTITUDES) OUGHT TO CONVEY THE RESPECT, SOLEMNITY, AND JOY OF THIS MOMENT WHEN CHRIST BECOMES OUR GUEST" (CCC #1387). CLOTHING THAT IS TOO CASUAL OR FLAMBOYANT CAN DISTRACT THE CONGREGATION FROM WHERE THEIR FOCUS SHOULD BE, ON THE LITURGY OF THE WORD AND THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST. ALL ARE RESPECTFULLY REQUESTED TO FOLLOW THE DRESS CODE BELOW:

FOR MEN: *SUIT IS FINE, OR DRESS SHIRT AND TIE, DRESS PANTS, DRESS SHOES.

*NO JEANS, TORN CLOTHES, SHORTS, FLIP-FLOPS, OR OTHER CLOTHING WHICH IS CONSIDERED INAPPROPRIATE OR TOO CASUAL

FOR WOMEN: *LADIES PANTS SUITS, DRESSES, DRESS SLACKS, SKIRTS AND BLOUSES. HEMLINES SHOULD BE MODEST (NO SHORTER THAN TO THE KNEE). NECKLINES SHOULD ALSO BE

*NO JEANS, TORN CLOTHES, SHORTS, FLIP-FLOPS, OR OTHER CLOTHING WHICH IS INAPPROPRIATE OR TOO CASUAL

CLOTHING FOR BOTH MEN AND WOMEN SHOULD FIT COMFORTABLY AND NOT BE FORM-FITTING OR TIGHT. MODESTY IN DRESS AND BEHAVIOR IS, THEREFORE, AN INDISPENSABLE WAY OF MAKING US MORE ATTENTIVE TO THE OBLIGATIONS WHICH WE CONTRACTED AT OUR BAPTISM.
