

Summer Dress Code in the Church

Women and girls shall come reverently and modestly dressed in skirts, dresses, loose fitting and appropriate pants suits or similar attire. Apparel worn by women and girls must not be overly casual, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative. Inappropriate dress, even though modest, should be avoided. For example, garish beachwear may be modest but is inappropriate at Mass. **Flip-flops** (of any kind) are another example of inappropriate dress.

Man and boys coming to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass shall come dressed properly. Garments that are overly casual: shorts, sandals, sleeveless, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative are not considered appropriate.
