#### JULY - MONTH OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD

The month of July is dedicated to the Most Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. Devotion to the Precious Blood is not a spiritual option, it is a spiritual Obligation, and that not only for priests but for every follower of Christ. About 96 A.D. says pope St. Clement I: "Let us fix our gaze on the Blood of Christ and realize how truly precious It is, seeing that It was pured out for our salvation and brought the grace of conversion to the whole world".

#### Prayer to the Most Precious Blood:

*O precious Blood of Jesus, infinite price paid for the redemption of sinful mankind. O Divine Blood, drink and laver of our souls, standing between us and the Father pleading mercy.*

*With all my heart I adore You, sweet Lord, and offer reparation for the insults, outrages and ingratitude, which You continuously receive from human beings, especially those who dare blaspheme the Divine Blood You shed for us.*

*Bless this Blood of Infinite value. Bless the fire of Jesus' Love who shed it to the last drop for us. Where would I be if not for this Divine Blood that redeemed me? Indeed, Lord, I have drawn if from You to the last drop.*

*What love! Thank You for this saving balm! May every heart, every tongue, now and forever, praise and thank this priceless balm, this saving Blood, this fountain of crimson Mercy welling up from the fountain of infinite Love. Amen.*

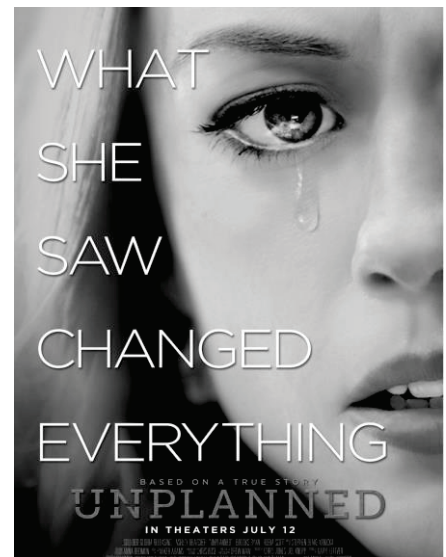
