Sacrament of Baptism

Those wishing to have their child baptized should call the Parish Office. Parents should be registered members of St. Gabriel's Parish. Please remember that Baptism dates fill up fast, so call early.

Sacrament of Marriage

At least one of the couple must be a registered member of St. Gabriel's Parish. We do not celebrate weddings during Lent. It is required that all couples attend a Marriage Preparation Course. 
FRIDAY PRAYER GROUP

THE CATECHISM CORNER

212. When does a person sin by superstition?

A person sins by superstition when he attributes to a creature a power that belongs to God alone, as when he makes use of charms or spells, believes in dreams or fortune-telling or goes to spiritists.

Neither let there be found among you any one that ... consulteth soothsayers, or observeth dreams and omens. Neither let there be any wizard, nor charmer. (Deuteronomy 19:10-11)

213. When does a person sin by sacrilege?

A person sins by sacrilege when he mistreats sacred persons, places, or things.

They have set thy sanctuary ablaze, they have profaned the dwelling of thy name on the earth. (Psalm 73:7)

214. Does the first commandment forbid us to honor the saints in heaven?

The first commandment does not forbid us to honor the saints in heaven, provided we do not give them the honor that belongs to God alone.

For, behold, henceforth all generations shall call me blessed. (Luke 1:48)

215. Why do we honor the saints in heaven?

We honor the saints in heaven because they practiced great virtue when they were on earth, and because in honoring those who are the chosen friends of God we honor God Himself.

Summer Dress Code In the Church

Man and boys coming to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass shall come dressed properly. Garments that are overly casual (shorts, sandals), sleeveless, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative are not considered appropriate.

Women and girls shall come reverently and modestly dressed in skirts, dresses, loose fitting and appropriate pants suits or similar attire. Apparel worn by women and girls must not be overly casual, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative. Inappropriate dress, even though modest, should be avoided. For example, garish beachwear may be modest but is inappropriate at Mass. <u>Flip-flops</u> (of any kind) are another example of inappropriate dress.
