LEGION OF MARY

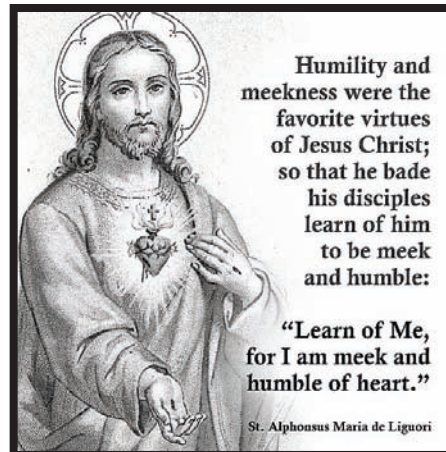

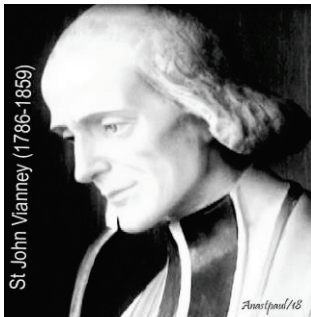

NINE FIRST FRIDAYS

At the end of the 17th century, Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alocoque (1647-1690) and asked her to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart. Our Lord made many promises to St.

Margaret Mary Alocoque regarding those who practice the Nine First Fridays and have a deep devotion to the Sacred Heart. "... they will not die under My displeasure or without receiving the Sacraments, My Divine Heart making Itself their assured refuge at the last moment." The specific conditions to fulfill the Great Promise are, therefore, twofold: they must be made on nine consecutive First Fridays of the month and they must receive Holy Communion; this assumes that the person is in the state of grace (recently went to confession).

We come to confession quite preoccupied with the shame that we shall feel. We accuse ourselves with hot air. It is said that many confess and few are converted. I believe it is so, my children, because few confess with tears of repentance.

THE CATECHISM CORNER

226. What is an oath?

An oath is the calling on God to witness the truth of what we say.

For men swear by one greater than themselves, and an oath given as a guarantee is the final settlement of all their disagreement. (Hebrews 6:16)

227. What things are necessary to make an oath lawful?

To make an oath lawful, three things are necessary: first, we must have a good reason for taking an oath; second, we must be convinced that what we say under oath is true; third, we must not swear, that is, take an oath, to do what is wrong.

And thou shalt swear: As the Lord liveth, in truth, and in judgment and in justice. (Jeremiah 4:2)

228. What great sin does a person commit who deliberately calls on God to bear witness to a lie?

A person who deliberately calls on God to bear witness to a lie commits the very grievous sin of perjury.

Thou shalt not swear falsely by my name, nor profane the name of thy God. (Leviticus 19:12)

229. What is a vow?

A vow is a deliberate promise made to God by which a person binds himself under pain of sin to do something that is especially pleasing to God.

When thou hast made a vow to the Lord thy God, thou shalt not delay to pay it; because the Lord thy God will require it. (Deuteronomy 23:21)



Summer Dress Code In the Church

Everybody is welcome despite their clothing. Respect for the Lord & His Church calls for the proper dress code.

Man and boys coming to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass shall come dressed properly. Garments that are overly casual sleeveless, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative are not considered appropriate. Shorts should reach the knees.

Women and girls shall come reverently and modestly dressed in skirts, dresses, loose fitting and appropriate pants suits or similar attire. Apparel worn by women and girls must not be overly casual, tight fitting, or otherwise immodest or provocative.

Inappropriate dress, even though modest, should be avoided. For example, garish beachwear may be modest but is inappropriate at Mass. **Flip-flops** (of any kind) are another example of inappropriate dress.
