DEVOTION FOR THE UNIVERSAL CHURCH



The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, historically known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi, celebrates the Real Presence of lesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul, Divinity. It is traditionally celebrated on the Thursday following the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. The feast dates to the Middle Ages and originated with a visionary nun and a Eucharistic miracle. St. Juliana (1193-1258) was a nun and mystic who had a series of visions in which she was instructed by Our Lord to work to

establish a liturgical feast for the Holy Eucharist, to which she had a great devotion. After many years of trying, she finally convinced the bishop, the future Pope Urban IV, to create this special feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament, where none had existed before. Soon after her death, Pope Urban instituted Corpus Christi for the Universal Church. We would like to invite both communities in our parish, English, and Polish, to take part in a procession for The Most Holy Body & Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ on Sunday, June 23 after the 12:30 pm Holy Mass. To form the dignified procession, we would like to ask all the altar servers to participate in this important event. All the girls from elementary schools are asked to come dress in white

to spread the flowers in front of the Most Holy Sacrament. All parish organizations are welcome. Please, come and help to prepare the altars on June 22 at 10:00 am at the Parish Centre. Help is also needed when placing the altars outside on June 23 at 10:15 am.

CAMPAIGN COMING THIS WAY

Preparations are under way at Parish here for the "One Heart, One Soul" Campaign, and across the diocese, early returns are promising! Through mid-May, 14 Pilot Wave parishes had raised a total of more than \$2.5 million, and an additional \$1.6 million had been pledged by other diocesan supporters and organizations. That total is about 12 percent of the campaign's \$35 million goal. The Pilot Wave will run through June, and three larger, additional waves will follow as the campaign gathers steam and continues through early 2021. Parish here is among more than 30 parishes and a number of mission churches taking part in the next wave. Through the summer, preparations will include forming a volunteer team, developing campaign materials and identifying projects. Kickoff Weekend is tentatively set for September. The campaign is aimed at strengthening parishes and several diocesan wide ministries.






