

RE: DONATION ENVELOPES

Dear Parishioners,

The collection counters strive to be accurate and efficient. On a regular basis, we deal with some practices that impede the counting routine. We would like to ask for your assistance by making the following suggestions:

- 1. We kindly ask you to not staple nor use tape to seal your donation envelopes. It is suggested however that you do seal the envelope. Money can fall out of an unsealed envelope.
- 2. If you should choose to use address labels, please place them on the front of the envelope and not on the back flap.
- 3. To ensure accuracy, it is advisable that the amount of the donation be printed on the front of the envelope. As well, the envelope number should be fully visible.
- 4. Please ask for a box of envelopes if you plan to donate on a regular basis. It makes it easier to record the donation. Do not use envelopes from prior years. Your number may have changed. Please let the office know of a change of address.
- 5. If possible, please do not fold the money bills. It is important that the bills lie flat for the bank deposit. Automated machines cannot process folded, bent or torn bills. Thank you.


