SYNOD OF BISHOPS 2023

Pope Francis recently announced that the next Synod of Bishops will take place in October 2023. The Theme of the Synod is: For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission. In the Diocese of Hamilton, a committee has been established to guide the Diocesan Phase of the Synodal Process. Information will be sent to the Parishes in late

October and the parishioners in the Diocese of Hamilton will have an opportunity to respond to the questions to be considered by the Synod. We pray for the success of this unique and historic synodal process:

Together with the Archdiocese of St. Boniface and the Diocese of Hamilton, we help to support the clergy and people of this missionary area (2,300,000 square km).


