ALL SAINTS DAY KIDS BALL

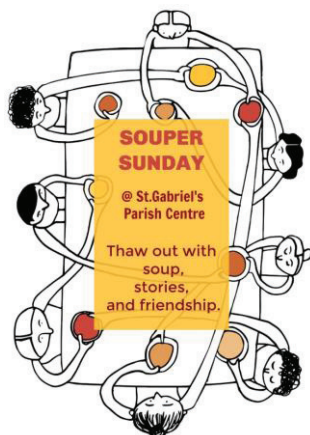
