

# ONE HEART, ONE SOUL CAMPAIGN

**UPDATE:** Thank you for your continued commitment to your pledge

payments. As mentioned in the spring, the majority of our parish goal was allocated to reducing our parish debt to the Diocese. (*Debt that was acquired to facilitate the parish centre additions.*) We have since paid down this debt by \$75,000. After discussion with the finance council it was decided to next use a portion of the available funds to repair our organ. The organ has an electronic system to add the 12 lowest notes in the organ. These notes are very often used and form the foundation for the pedal of the organ. The attempt to repair the system was unsuccessful, and therefore requires replacement at a cost of approximately \$4800. This repair will be completed in January 2023.
