THE SEASON OF LENT



ASH WEDNESDAY: Lent begins Ash Wednesday, March 2nd. *Ash Wednesday is a universal day of fasting and abstinence from meat.*

There will be Mass at 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Similar to last year, ashes will be sprinkled on the top (above) each person's head.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Join us Fridays of Lent at 7:00 p.m. for Stations of the Cross followed by Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and concluding with Benediction around 8:30 p.m.

LENTEN BIBLE STUDY: By the Paschal mystery, the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ we are saved. The narrative of each of the Gospels leads us to that moment at which Jesus gives his life for the salvation of the world. On Palm Sunday each year we listen to one of the Passion accounts from one of the synoptic Gospels: Matthew, Mark, and Luke, and each year on Good Friday we listen to the Gospel according to John. Join us on the **four Saturdays of March** (March 5, 12, 19, and 26) as Father Ed will lead us through an examination of the Passion narratives from each of the Gospels. We will begin with Mass at 8:30 a.m. followed by the talk in the parish hall.
