**FIRST WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY: Sunday, June 25**  
**"I am with you always"**

Pope Francis announced the establishment of a World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly at his Sunday Angelus in January of this year. The chosen day for the yearly celebration is the fourth Sunday of July, since it coincides with the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents. During his presentation, Pope Francis reminded us about grandparents: *"Their voice is precious because it sings the praises of God and safeguards the roots of peoples. They remind us that old age is a gift and that grandparents are the link between generations, passing on the experience of life and faith to the young. Grandparents are often forgotten and we forget this wealth of preserving roots and passing on."*
