JUNE: MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has a long history but it became more widespread in the Church after the personal revelation of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alocoque in the 17th century. Jesus commissioned her with the work of spreading this devotion. The devotion of the Sacred Heart reminds us that the heart of Jesus was pierced for us. Our Lord suffered for love of us. This devotion is intimately linked to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Divine Mercy and above all, the Eucharist - the Sacrament of Jesus' Body and Blood. The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is a special day to pray for the sanctification of priests. This year it falls on the June 24th.
