ADVENT REFLECTION SERIES: This fall marks the 60th anniversary of the First Session of Second Vatican Council. In a homily on October 11 to mark the anniversary of the beginning of the Council, Pope Francis said, "To rekindle her love for the Lord, the Church, for the first time in her history, devoted a Council to examining herself and reflecting on her nature and mission". Join us Saturday mornings **November 26, December 3, and December 10** as Father Ed leads us through a look at the document *Lumen Gentium*, (The Light of the Nations) which is the Council's document on the nature of the Church. We will begin with Mass at 8:30 a.m. followed by a talk in the Parish Centre, concluding at 10:30 a.m. All are welcome.
