ADVENT REFLECTION SERIES: This fall marks the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the First Session of Second Vatican Council. ## INDULGENCES FOR SOULS IN PURGATORY:

**November 1 – 8:** You can obtain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the souls in purgatory if you devoutly visit a cemetery and, at least mentally, pray for the departed. **On All Soul's Day** (Nov. 2): You can receive a plenary indulgence for the souls in purgatory, if you devoutly visit a church or oratory and recite an Our Father and the Creed. In addition, all indulgences require offering prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father, going to Confession (about 20 days either before or after) and the reception of Holy Communion.
