We are very much still open and delivering services in ways that are safe yet meet the needs of our young women. We have a **full residence with 10 moms and babies** and we are getting calls for more clients looking to come in – three we are assessing right now.


The moms are doing school activities in the morning and group activities in the afternoon, while maintaining social distancing. Our school students are getting assignments from the teachers and our counsellors are working with them individually by phone each day. The young women are doing well – it is trying for them, but they have really risen to show their resilience.
