

### **Petition to Reject Bill C-7**

On February 24, at the press conference announcing Bill C-7, the bill to expand euthanasia in Canada, the Federal government estimated that there had been more than 13,000 assisted deaths with 5444



in 2019 and 4438 in 2018. The new Ontario assisted death data indicates that there were 570 reported assisted deaths in the first three months of 2020 with 199 in March alone. The euthanasia rate is sadly increasing, even during the Covid-19 crisis. The Canadian government must reject Bill C-7 and begin the promised 5-year review of the euthanasia law with an open view to what is actually happening rather than continuing to expand euthanasia, making Canada the most permissive euthanasia regime in the world.
