Pope Encourages Rosary for May



Pope Francis is calling all Catholics to dedicate the month of May to praying the Rosary.

Noting that May is traditionally the month "when the people of God express with particular intensity their love and devotion for the Blessed Virgin Mary," Pope Francis is challenging the faithful to pray the Rosary faithfully, either individually or as a family. In an April 25 letter, the pope told the faithful, "The key to doing this is always simplicity, and it is easy also on the internet to find good models of prayers to follow," wrote Francis.

Echoing the late Ven. Fr. Patrick Peyton, "the Rosary priest" of the 20th century who once popularized the phrases "The family that prays together stays together" and "A world at prayer is a world at peace," Pope Francis acknowledged the importance of family prayer and the powerful effect it has on cohesiveness in the family and the world.

In countless apparitions of the 19th and 20th centuries, including those officially accepted by the Church, Mary is often holding a Rosary and is always imploring her spiritual children to pray — for repentance, reparation for sin and peace in our hearts.

Consecration of Canada to the Blessed Virgin Mary



At this spiritually troubling time in world history, the U.S. and Canadian Catholic bishops have brought abundant spiritual and material protection to our countries by reconsecrating them to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church on Friday, May 1, 2020.

By imploring the intercession of the Mother of God, our bishops have united the faithful in the hope which only faith in God can bring. This is a great spiritual initiative which other Catholic bishops, around the world, have already done in their own countries.

We thank the bishops for reconsecrating our country to Our Lady, Mother of the Church.

Archbishop Gomez, President of the USCCB sent a letter about the reconsecation to his brother bishops, stating:

"Every year, the Church seeks the special intercession of the Mother of God during the month of May. This year, we seek the assistance of Our Lady all the more earnestly as we face together the effects of the global pandemic."

Let us pray that these actions serve to enliven the souls of the faithful in the United States and Canada, who are suffering as a result of being unable to access the Sacraments at this time. In this way, the COVID-19 crisis can be an event which inspires deeper devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in every family, and not just something to be suffered through.

We can also consecrate our family and home to the Blessed Virgin with the Act of Consecration below.

Act of Consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary

O Mary, Virgin most powerful and Mother of mercy, Queen of Heaven and Refuge of sinners, we consecrate ourselves to thine Immaculate Heart.

We consecrate to thee our very being and our whole life; all that we have, all that we love, all that we are. To thee we give our bodies, our hearts and our souls; to thee we give our homes, our families, our country. We desire that all that is in us and around us may belong to thee and may share in the benefits of thy motherly benediction. And that this act of consecration may be truly efficacious and lasting, we renew this day at thy feet the promises of our Baptism and our first Holy Communion. We pledge ourselves to profess courageously and at all times the truths of our holy Faith, and to live as befits Catholics who are duly submissive to all the directions of the Pope and the Bishops in communion with him. We pledge ourselves to keep the commandments of God and His Church, in particular to keep holy the Lord's Day. We likewise pledge ourselves to make the consoling practices of the Christian religion, and above all, Holy Communion, an integral part of our lives, in so far as we shall be able so to do.

Finally, we promise thee, O glorious Mother of God and loving Mother of men, to devote ourselves whole-heartedly to thy service, in order to hasten and assure, through the sovereignty of thine Immaculate Heart, the coming of the kingdom of the Sacred Heart of thine adorable Son, in our own hearts and in those of all men, in our country and in all the world. As in heaven, so on earth.


