



We have said goodbye with the hope that they will let us know periodically how they are doing. There is still a fund available to support another family or join with another parish to help some refugees. We will work with Erin Pease of the Diocese to see where our efforts are needed. Through your generosity, this family has come to Canada. They and our committee thank you.
