## DIOCESE OF HAMILTON

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ:

Once again we look forward to a week of celebration of Catholic education in our Diocese. The theme of this year's celebration is "Growing Together in Faith". This theme emphasizes two important aspects of our Catholic schools. The first is that our Catholic schools are places of growth. Growth is evident everywhere in Catholic education from the wonderful enthusiasm of kindergarten children to the wonder-filled questions of young people to the heart of discernment in our Catholic university students. And I am grateful for the adults who care for these young people and who, themselves, are open to growing in their own faith as they journey with students. Secondly, the theme reminds us that our journey of faith is not solitary. We grow together - together in families, in classrooms and staffrooms, and in our parishes.

Every day in our schools, children, young people and adults are rooted ever more fully in the life of Christ. We celebrate in a particular way, not our own goodness, but the goodness of Almighty God who loves us and saves us. This is a time to celebrate God's work in our midst and to remember how it is that God works in and through us.

We know we are made in the image of God. For that reason we are convinced of the dignity of all people. This is how our Catholic schools are communities of love and charity. We are nurtured, too, by that same life-giving Spirit breathed into us in creation that animates each one of us today. This is the Holy Spirit who leads us in truth, who guides our discernment and who gives life to our witness.

It is because we are securely rooted, because we know who we are and whose we are, that we are able to witness to our faith. This is a gift in a world where people yearn for meaning and often live in despair. Let us stand proud, rooted in the love of Christ, and nurtured by prayer, and let us continue to profess by our actions, by our very being, that there is hope. Let us show the world a faith that is rooted, witnessed and celebrated. Let all the world see the love of Christ dwelling in our hearts!
