At this Mass, the Holy Oils used in the administrations of the Sacraments will be blessed and consecrated and distributed to all parishes in the Diocese of Hamilton. Only a Bishop can consecrate Chrism, a pure olive oil infused with a rich fragrance. Two other sacrament oils, the unscented olive oil for Catechumens and the Oil of the Sick will be blessed in the same Liturgy and taken carefully home to every parish in the Diocese of Hamilton. This liturgy is a sign of the unity of the local church and the Bishop's ministry to all who will be Baptized and Confirmed and ordained in the coming year. Plan to attend.
