



As a property owner in Ontario, you're entitled to direct your school support to English separate Catholic - which, in Hamilton, is the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board. As a registered Separate school supporter, you have a say in who will represent your interests at the school board and other levels of government. You don't have to have children in a Catholic school to register as a Separate school supporter ... you only have to be Catholic.
