



- enabling your support to the parish to be continued, allowing the parish's reoccurring maintenance expenses to be paid, even if you are not present on the weekend or if mass is cancelled (as in the past).

From the Vatican, 6 August 2015 Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. LETTER (in part) OF HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE "WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF CREATION" [1st SEPTEMBER]

As Christians we wish to contribute to resolving the ecological crisis which humanity is presently experiencing. In doing so, we must first rediscover in our own rich spiritual patrimony the deepest motivations for our concern for the care of creation. We need always to keep in mind that, for believers in Jesus Christ, the Word of God who became man for our sake, "the life of the spirit is not dissociated from the body or from nature or from worldly realities, but lived in and with them, in communion with all that surrounds us" (*Laudato Si*, 216). The ecological crisis thus summons us to a profound spiritual conversion: Christians are called to "an ecological conversion whereby the effects of their encounter with Jesus Christ become evident in their relationship with the world around them" (ibid., 217). For "living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue; it is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience" (ibid.). - *THE GREEN TEAM* https://www.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/letters/2015/documents/papa-francesco_20150806_lettera-giornata-cura-creato.html
