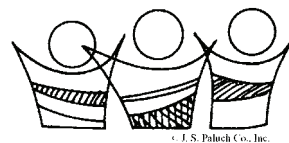

Dear Parishioners,

Despite various restrictions over the past year, we were still able to do a great deal at Regina Mundi thanks to God's grace and the excellent work of Robyn, Deacon Randy, Jim and Terry Bryce, our parish staff, and so many others. I am exceedingly proud of our parish and so grateful for the hard work of so many who keep everything going. Over the last two years, while many parishes halted most of their activities, over three hundred people have participated in the various programs we offer, and over the last twelve months we have provided:

- A Biblical Walk Through the Mass (34 participants)
- No Greater Love: A Biblical Walk Through Christ's Passion (39 participants)
- Epic: The Early Church (38 participants)
- Bible Timeline: The Story of Salvation (46 participants)
- The Chosen watch parties (~13 participants)
- The Search (10 participants)
- Encounter Evenings (7 evenings run with parishioner testimonies and Eucharistic Adoration)
- Faith Studies (37 participants completed all 5 books - Discovery, Source, Growth, Trust, Commission)
- Ignatian Retreats (Deacon Randy and Robyn ran two with about 10 participants/retreat)

In the fall of 2021, we celebrated the first Communions for children in our three parish schools who were not able to do it in the spring. We also celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation for the children in our three schools — two were in the spring and one in the fall. Over the year we celebrated six weddings, fifty infant baptisms, forty funerals, and received two adults into the Catholic Church.

I am so grateful to God for His many blessings, and to the many, many, people who assist with everything that goes on at Regina Mundi, and to all of you for your support of the parish and its work. It truly is a team effort! As we now embark on 2022, my hope is that we can continue to cooperate with God and carry out His good work at Regina Mundi.

With our deepest gratitude we thank the parish for your generosity in supporting the One Heart One Soul Campaign for the Regina Mundi Parish.

We would like to explain the projects we have been able to undertake as a result of the campaign. We are proud to offer parishioners air conditioning in the parish. This has gone a long way to make mass more comfortable during the summer months.

We have had the steeple painted. The rust was beginning to show through the paint, as it chipped away. The new coat of paint has really cleaned up the exterior and extended the life of our steeple.

We will also be replacing the glass panels comprising the skylights. This will stop any leakage and be more energy efficient. In addition to this we will be replacing the windows in the Narthex. These windows are original to the church and have simply worn over the years.

We will also be looking into replacing all the windows on the second floor of the building, comprising the offices and meeting rooms. These windows are also original to the building and the office especially has become quite drafty in the winter months.
