Also assisting were Bishop Tonnos' good friend Monsignor Dominic Pizzacalla, from St. Catharines, and our own Monsignor Harvey Roach. Thanks to Monsignor Murray Kroetsch for assuring the Mass flowed well, and to Monsignor Ed House, for arranging a wonderful dinner in the parish hall.
