New window systems were installed along the southeast wall of the Parish Hall. A small addition was built onto the old meeting room addition to create a new Parish Hall entrance, coat room and store room for tables and chairs. A Parish reheat kitchen was built. Washroom facilities were upgraded. Barrier free access was built into the overall design. A new church parking lot was built. The Parish Library was moved to the Church level. The Blessed Sacrament Chapel received a new entrance. The architect of this project was Sam Esposto.

Refugee Communiqué

What if you came to Canada and had to learn everything in a new language? Such is the plight of our present refugee family. Refugee camps lack the things that we Canadians take for granted. In the camp there was no oven; one cooked on a small gas flame or an outdoor fire. There was no refrigeration so eggs were kept in a cupboard and one purchased only a few things each day. Travel in the camps was somewhat restricted so taking buses here is now a new and fun activity. Toasters, ovens and microwaves are all unfamiliar yet they are equipment one must learn to use and keep clean now that they are in Canada.

The greatest challenge is learning the language and understanding how to pronounce words and phrases. Why is one bit of water called a bay and the next section called a lake? What does one mean when they say “catch you later”? For our young refugees learning is fun and rapid. For the adult learner the process is slower and complicated by the inability at present to read written English. Added to all of this is the extra layer of learning required to grasp laws and rules of daily city living. Our committee is making this transition a little easier and we have had many donations of household goods and furniture to ease the cost of settlement. The Sisters of Saint Joseph are supporting the family financially for 6 months and the government provides a 6 month support. In one year the family must be self-sufficient so the learning for them is essential to ensure their eventual independence. They have embraced a busy and demanding schedule to accomplish this goal and appear to be happily engaged in the process.

Our Regina Mundi Volunteers are learning what is needed to support refugees. We will continue to use the guidance of the Sisters of St. Joseph and the Immigrant Workers Centre. With the donations raised in the Regina Mundi monthly donation envelopes, we plan to help another family within the year. We hope you will continue to give generously to this work.

Our **Annual 9 day Novena to St. Ann** will begin with 7pm evening Mass Monday, July 18th and conclude Tuesday, July 26th. Deacon Joe DiLoreto will be the homilist. Anointing of the Sick on Friday, July 22nd at 7pm. The Most Reverend Douglas Crosby will celebrate Mass on Tuesday, July 26th at 7pm the Feast of St. Ann. Reception to follow in School gym. All Welcome. Wheelchair accessible
