### Refugee Communique:

You have heard the phrase, "it takes a village to raise a child". Well this applies to helping refugees who come here with only their clothing. Our committee has found that several agencies and groups as well as our volunteers and donors are needed to make the resettlement to Canada work well. Our committee for this family is composed of individuals from Regina Mundi, from St. Joseph's parish, the companions of the Sisters and Sr. Ann and Sr. Joan of the Congregation of St. Joseph When the family from Burma arrived they were met by Sister Ann and Regina Mundi drivers Marcell Nainee and Mark Gallant. They put on winter coats provided by Good Shepherd and Regina Mundi donors and were greeted in Karen- their language, by an interpreter from the Immigrant Workers Centre. They stayed for 2 weeks with a Karen family provided by the IWC until our committee could find an apartment.

This family is being financed by the Sisters of St. Joseph, the Companions of the Sisters and several anonymous donors and of course the federal government. All of the items in their apartment from toilet brush to chairs and tables are donated items. Our parishioners have been so generous that we have been able to help two other refugee families who are being sponsored by other groups.

The funds being collected at our parish in the goldenrod colored envelopes are being raised to support our own refugee family. Please be generous. There is more to come on this in the future as the committee is yet to be established for our own family.
