

<u>Mary, Mother of the Church:</u> Join us at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King for 12 Noon Mass on Monday, June 10, 2019 for the Feast of Mary, Mother of the Church. This feast which Pope Francis instituted last year is celebrated annually on the Monday after Pentecost. It recalls the title given to Our Lady by Pope Saint Paul VI during the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965). In the Council document, *Lumen Gentium* (Constitution of the Church), the Blessed Mother is spoken of in the final chapter. She is described as the first disciple of the Lord, and mother of the Church. The teaching of the Council echoes the long held Catholic belief about Mary, the Virgin Mother of the Lord Jesus. On the Cross the Lord entrusted the care of his mother to Saint John, and entrusted him – and through him all believers – to Mary's maternal care. Campaign coming this way

Preparations are under way at Parish here for the "One Heart, One Soul"

Campaign, and across the diocese, early returns are promising! Through mid-May, 14 Pilot Wave parishes had raised a total of more than \$2.5 million, and an additional \$1.6 million had been pledged by other diocesan supporters and organizations. That total is about 12 percent of the campaign's \$35 million goal. The Pilot Wave will run through June, and three larger, additional waves will follow as the campaign gathers steam and continues through early 2021. Parish here is among more than 30 parishes and a number of mission churches taking part in the next wave. Through the summer, preparations will include forming a volunteer team, developing campaign materials and identifying projects. Kickoff Weekend is tentatively set for September. The campaign is aimed at strengthening parishes and several diocesanwide ministries.
