

THIS OLD CHURCH OF OURS

I was able to methodically address the maintenance and repair of the Church pew kneelers and the bumper bracket hardware that attach the kneelers to the pews. I was even able to start a few new painting projects as well.

With the second lockdown behind us, we all still find ourselves living in Covid times with modified routines. So, please stay safe. Stay well. Stay connected. And, until next time, this is Michael Pollard for this old Church of ours.
