**<u>Parenting Tip of the Month:</u>** For many of our children Lent is a time to give something up; it



becomes simply a time of selfdenial. Parents need to help their children understand that Lent is really a time to connect with their baptism and the teachings of our

faith - it is a time to prepare ourselves for Easter. Explain to your children that we give something up as an act of self-denial, but also to unite ourselves with the world's poor; we fast, not just from food, but from poor behaviours and actions that do not make us Christ like; we pray, not just for ourselves, but for all those in need. Reading and talking about Jesus' passion, praying as a family, engaging together in works of charity – these are all ways that families can journey through Lent together.
