

Daylight Savings Time is Sunday March 10th and we are reminded to keep our families safe by changing our smoke & carbon monoxide detector batteries. BATTERIES contain toxic metals such as lithium, cadmium, nickel & mercury & when dumped into landfills can burst, poisoning soil, ground water & plant life. Animals often mistaken them for food & die when batteries burst in their stomachs. As good stewards of God's Earth we strive to keep all life safe by properly disposing of used batteries. You may bring your dead batteries to church during the next two weekends & drop them in the green bins in the narthex. THE GREEN TEAM will safely dispose of them...just one way that Regina Mundi is caring for Creation.

Lenten Observances

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **fasting** in the Latin rite of the Catholic Church (i.e., the rite that we belong to). Vatican II also recommends fasting on Holy Saturday until the Easter Vigil (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 110). Fridays throughout the year (including during Lent) are days of **abstinence**.

The law of abstinence prohibits the eating of meat, but eggs, milk products, and sauces made from animal fats may be eaten, as well as fish and all cold-blooded animals (e.g., frogs, clams, turtles). The law of fasting means that only one full meal may be taken during the day; two light meals are permitted (the quantity of food taken at the two lighter meals should not exceed the quantity taken at the full meal). The consumption of solid food between meals is prohibited, but liquids may be taken at any time.

Only those between the ages of 18 and 59, and whose health permits them to fast, are bound by the law of fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those 14 years of age and older are bound by the law of abstinence on all Fridays throughout the year (unless a solemnity falls on the Friday).
