

# Canadian Children Are Being Born Pre-polluted.

Environmental Defence tested the umbilical cord blood of 3 anonymous newborns in the Greater Toronto Area and Hamilton for PBDEs (flame retardants), PCBs (a banned chemicals), PFCs (found in non-stick coatings), Organochlorine pesticides, dioxins and furans, mercury and lead which are chemicals that are known to be pervasive in the environment and are linked to serious health problems. Out of the 310 chemicals tested for, a total of 137 were found in the 3 babies showing that babies are being burdened with a toxic chemical load before they are born. When it comes to toxic chemicals and our environment, it is more evident than ever that there's no time to waste. Expectant mothers can't protect themselves and their children from toxic chemicals that are pervasive in our environment and household products. That's why we need to see strong action from government to get toxic chemicals out of products.
