

1999 - The Church's Third Roof System: A complete redesign of the entire Church roofing system is done. Plans for this renovation began while Rev. Bob Bulbrook was Pastor

but were not completed until Rev. Wallace Metcalf became Pastor. The engineering firm Peto MacCullum was responsible for the redesign of the roof systems. A "modified bitumen" roof was applied after significant upgrades to the roof deck were made. The biggest upgrade to the roof deck was to the roof's insulation. Modified bitumen membranes replaced all of the asphalt shingle roofs, tar and gravel roofs and mopped on asphalt sheet roofs. For an accent, the high-sloped roof was covered with slate tiles. The Church central exhaust fan was significantly upgraded to improve the flow of air within the Church. The four skylights above the Sanctuary were replaced with new thermopane skylights.

Refugee Communique

In January 2016 Regina Mundi parishioners began discussions with the Sisters of St. Joseph regarding a partnership to help refugees. The Sisters and their Companions group had already been supporting a young woman here who was originally from Eritrea. Now in their second mission to help a refugee family, they welcomed the support offered by Regina Mundi volunteers.

This second family arrived in Hamilton in March of this year. The Sisters, the Immigrant Workers Centre and the committee all worked together to help the family of mom and two young men get settled. We want to thank the many parishioners who donated household items and the volunteers who helped clean the apartment and move in the donated furniture.

Now the adjustment to a new culture, a different environment, and a new language must happen. The Immigrant Workers Centre is helping with the resettlement and the Regina Mundi volunteers are performing tasks such as tutoring, driving, demonstrating how to use the buses, and orientation to the city. The adjustment period will likely involve one or two years.

The hope of the committee is to continue to assist this family and with the support of the parish to assist other refugees who wish to settle in Hamilton.

Year of Mercy Pilgrimage Sunday: The next Pilgrimage Sunday at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King will take place this Sunday, May 15th. The Cathedral will open to pilgrims at 2 p.m. The Door of Mercy can be accessed through the doors adjacent to the Cathedral Rectory. At 2:30 p.m. prayer in the style of Taize - Scripture and meditative chants will be offered. You are welcome to join us for the 4 p.m. Mass - Monsignor Earl Talbot will preside and preach. A plenary indulgence may be gained by the faithful who enter through the Door of Mercy. In order to gain the indulgence pilgrims enter the door. make a profession of faith and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. They should also receive Holy Communion and celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation within 20 days of the pilgrimage.
