

For the past several decades, the Pope has blessed the Baby Jesus figurines from Nativity Scenes that belong to families, and the families themselves, in St. Peter's Square in Rome. The blessing takes place on Gaudete Sunday, the third Sunday of Advent, and is known as **Bambinelli Sunday**. The blessing of the 'Bambinelli' – as they are known in Rome – reminds us
