"Walk with Christ: Justice for the Poor" is an annual board-wide fundraiser which, since 2004, has raised more than \$479,479.32 for development projects in the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Uganda, as well as the Holy Childhood Association and the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace. The pilgrimage will begin with a Eucharistic celebration at Cathedral High School at 30 Wentworth Street North at 11 a.m. sharp, followed by an 8-kilometre walk at approximately 12p.m. up the Wentworth escarpment trail to St. Daniel Catholic Elementary School on Anson Avenue.
