

Contribution Envelopes will soon to be processed **BUT** please consider using our **PRE-AUTHORIZED** <u>GIVING PLAN (Electronic Fund Transfer) for your church contributions.</u> **EFT** (helps especially during these uncertain pandemic times) by:

- eliminating any chance of COVID19 transmission on paper/money for our counters
- saving the expense of purchasing boxes of contribution envelopes (approx. \$2,500/yr)
- enabling your support to the parish to be continued, allowing the parish's reoccurring maintenance expenses to be paid, even if you are not present on the weekend or if mass is cancelled (as in the past).

The Story of Salvation Bible Study: We will be running <u>The Bible Timeline</u> which takes you on a twenty-four-part guided journey through salvation history. Presenter Jeff Cavins shows you how fourteen of the Bible's narrative books tell the biblical story from beginning to end and gives you the keys to understanding the amazing story woven throughout Scripture. We will be **starting September 21st** and we will be running this study on **Tuesdays at 1:00pm (in person) or 7:00pm (via Zoom)**. To register, please visit our parish website. The Search: Sometimes we get so caught up in the depth of our faith that we forget what it was like to wrestle with the big questions – Who am I? What am I searching for? What's our shared story? Who is Jesus? Why do we need a Church? Is there a God? We need to get back to the basics to make sure the foundation is strong.

We are excited to be piloting a new evangelization program called The Search. This 7-part series is intended to light the first fire in those who don't yet know the faith or reignite the fire in those who need a primer on the foundational questions. This will run on Wednesday nights at 7:00pm via Zoom, starting September 29th. We will be running <u>"Encounter</u>" again on the first Friday of every month. The next one coming up will be on **Friday October 1 from 7:00 – 8:30pm**. This event will start off with parishioner testimonies, followed by Holy Hour and Praise & Worship. This will be a beautiful evening of prayer, adoration, and community.
