

The **RCIA** is an exploration of the essentials of the Catholic faith in a series of weekly meetings. It is an opportunity to ask those questions you have always had, and to explore your own faith and membership in the Church.

RCIA is not a course with papers and marks. Rather, it is a weekly gathering with like-minded inquirers, parishioners, and parish staff. It is an opportunity to learn more about God's revelation in Jesus Christ and the life of the Church that Jesus founded.

We are now beginning preparations for 2018-2019. Meetings will take place Wednesday evenings from 7-9 p.m. beginning on October 17th. We also offer a version of RCIA tailored to children for those in Grade 3 or older who have not yet been baptized. Sessions for them will begin in October.
