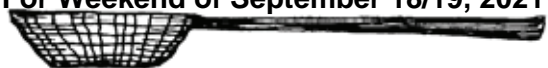

At the same time, we can also see how it has made it easier for us to become alienated from our environment, and it's given new and efficient ways to plunder the world's natural resources en masse.
