- **★** Our sponsorship application is with the Diocese. **St. Mark's is now 4**<sup>th</sup> in line to be matched with a potential family. This process will still require several weeks, maybe more, to move ahead. Please stay tuned!
- **★ Translators needed!** St. Mark's Refugee Settlement Committee is now seeking translators. While professional and volunteer translation services are available, we'd like to engage members of our parish. The official language of Syria is modern Arabic; there's also a possibility that the family may be more comfortable with other dialects. If you're fluent in Arabic, Levantine, Mesopotamian, Kurdish, Armenian or Azeri (or know someone who is), we'd love to hear from you!
