
All are most welcome to attend.

If you are unable to join us, you may wish to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet at home, using an ordinary rosary...

**1. Begin with:** The Sign of the Cross, 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and The Apostles Creed.

### **2.** Then on the Our Father Beads say the following:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.



**3.** On the 10 Hail Mary Beads say the following: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Repeat step 2 and 3 for all five decades).

**4. Conclude with (three times):** Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

**Two New Saints** are now celebrated by the universal Church – **John XXIII** and **John Paul II** – as I write this I am not yet aware of how they are to be called. Someone asked me if we would be having a Mass for their intentions. No, because they have no need of our prayers. They are in heaven. The church knows and proclaims this reality. We ask for their intercessory prayers.

The process leading to canonization includes the rigorous examination of the life of the one whose cause is brought fourth. An appointed and well-trained 'devil's advocate' (likely a committee of experts) do everything possible to uncover information that would prevent the individual from becoming a canonized saint. Once someone's extraordinary holiness has been established, miracles attributed to the intercession of this 'candidate' for canonization must be proven beyond all doubt. It is this that attests to the reality that this holy person is in fact already in heaven.

And so, we pray to John XXIII and John Paul II and universally acknowledge them as heavenly intercessors. Remember, the above were flesh and bones men, living as ordinary men do. Their holiness was the result of the power of God's saving and sanctifying grace active within them. This can happen to anyone who follows Our Lady's example by giving their total 'yes' to the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

Pope John and Pope John Paul, pray for us.
