Offertory envelopes can be requested by filling out a parish registration form, or if you are already registered, simply call the office to request a box. Debit plan enrollment forms are available in the church lobby.

BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated during Sunday Mass. Two months' notice is required. Please pick up a baptism form in the church lobby, introduce yourself to Father after Mass and give him your completed form at that time. Dates for preparation and the baptism will be confirmed by the parish office only after you have met with Father.

MARRIAGE

At least 6 months' notice is required. Please introduce yourselves to Father after Mass to set up an appointment.

New Film Invites Us to Really Know the Blessed Virgin Mary

Dr. Josephine Lombardi is a faculty member at St. Augustine's Seminary in Toronto. She recently released, "<u>The First Lady and Her</u> <u>Successors</u>," a film that explores the many ways that the Blessed Mother Mary can guide us today. She discussed this new film below.

All Christians know Mary of Nazareth is the mother of Jesus. Depending on their upbringing or catechetical background, Catholics and other Christians may not know a lot about her life or role in salvation history. The inspiration for the film was my desire for all people to know Mary of Nazareth with greater intimacy, using Scripture as the starting point.

The film is about the life of Mary, beginning with the Book of Genesis and ending with the Book of Revelation. We journey with Mary as we reflect on mysteries, events, words and actions associated with her earthly life. Accompanying us along the way, we have the stories of nine amazing women, sharing how their own life experiences help them understand and relate to Mary's journey.

The focus of the film is Mary in Sacred Scripture. Although Marian dogmas are implied throughout, the focus is the life of Mary as found in the Bible.

WCDSB seeks external community member to serve on Audit Committee

The Waterloo Catholic District School Board has had an Audit Committee, as required by the Ministry of Education since 2009. The mandate of the Committee is to ensure compliance with the Education Act (253.1(1)) and Ontario Regulation (361/10), and to provide independent oversight for the Board of Trustees in the areas of financial reporting, external audit, risk management, internal controls, and compliance matters.

The Audit Committee is comprised of 3 Trustees (appointed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees) and 2 external community members who are appointed by the Board of Trustees based on a selection process. The Director of Education, Chief Financial Officer and Internal Audit Officer attend all meetings, as well as others as required.

The Board requires 1 external community representative with a high level of financial and business knowledge to serve on their Audit Committee.

This is a volunteer position. The committee meets five (5) times per year, plus ad hoc meetings as required. Meetings are usually held Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday evenings in September, November, January, March and June.
