The Virtues - Channels of God's Grace

On Thursday, December 6th we will begin a series of 13 evenings based on **Living a Virtuous Life**. Virtues are the good habits of life, without which we cannot channel or turn into action the graces that are given to us by God. During these sessions we will speak on a given virtue, for instance: **chastity, humility, temperance, courage, justice, charity**, etc.

Each evening will be about 1 hour long, consisting of a talk, quiet prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, petition, public prayer, and will conclude with Benediction. All are welcome to come.

The first evening **(Thurs. Dec. 6th at 7:00 p.m.)** we will have what some have called an "explained Mass." The mass will take on a slightly different format, without interrupting or altering the integrity nor the reverence of the Mass.

During this celebration we will discuss things like:

- why do we call this celebration the "mass";
- what do the vestments mean and represent;
- why does the priest wash his hands;
- what are the Epiclesis and the Anamnesis of the mass;
- why does the priest break a small piece of the host into the chalice;
- why do we say "the Lord be with you" so many times during the Mass?

I hope this will help us all to understand the Mass more, so as to be able to enter into the sacred mystery more fully.

All are welcome to attend. A schedule will be given out to all at the first evening, and will also be published in the bulletin. God bless.
