Dear friends in Christ.



The reality that we are connected to our past never seems more true than at Christmas. The old folks present at the Christmas celebrations remind me of the two greatest things we possess: **faith** and **family**, largely due to their efforts.

We were not always as charitable as we could have been (when discussing how boring Father's sermon was this year). Our *Grace Before Meals* was not always as reverent as it should have been (often interrupted with a few "shut-up's!" to try to keep the children quiet).
