Ash Wednesday: a day of fasting and abstinence

This week we will celebrate Ash Wednesday which will begin our season of Lent. Lent is a precious time of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving in preparation for our celebrations of Easter, when Christ died and rose from the dead for our salvation. Ash Wednesday is also a day of fasting and abstinence. There are only two days of fasting and abstinence prescribed by the Church: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (Code of Canon Law #1251).

Fasting means eating less than normal. We are asked to eat one regular size meal and two smaller meals. Catholics between the ages of 16-60 are asked abide by this discipline.

Abstinence means abstaining from eating meat on this day. Catholics older than 14 years of age are asked to abide by this discipline.

Stations of the Cross will be offered each Friday during Lent. We will have Mass at 6:00 p.m. followed by the stations which will begin immediately after Mass. During the Friday evening Masses I will give short talks stretched over the Fridays on Jesus' march to Jerusalem, His trial, His sentencing, His way to the cross and crucifixion. I hope these will help us understand more the mystery of Christ's passion, death and resurrection. I will have stations of the cross booklets out for anyone who may wish to make the way of the cross privately before other weekday Masses.


