#### Famous Catholic Prayers (PART 6)

There are various forms of the Act of Contrition (sorrow). Below is one of them. Sorrow is an essential aspect of true repentance. There are two types of sorrow – perfect and imperfect. Imperfect sorrow is the regret we have for our actions because they got us into trouble, or caused us to lose the trust and confidence of others. Such sorrow arises from the fact that our life has been made worse or disadvantaged because of our choices and actions. It is, of course, better than nothing and sufficient when we make a good sacramental confession. Hopefully, the graces of forgiveness will raise us to a level of true or perfect sorrow.

**Perfect sorrow** arises from the fact that we regret hurting someone that we love. We become aware that the offended deserved better from us and, therefore, the pain of our heart is the knowledge that the beloved is hurt.

The following Act of Contrition can be used daily, particularly after making a good examination of conscience or after making a sacramental confession.

In relation to the above, St. Ignatius advises all Christians to end their day by:

- 1. Thanking God for all the blessings of the day;
- 2. Expressing sorrow for sins committed during the day (or sins of omission);
- 3. Asking for the grace we will need to do well tomorrow.

#### **Act of Contrition**

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins because of Thy just punishments, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who art all-good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.

P.S. – As a confessor, I must say that most confessions that I have heard are closer to perfect rather than imperfect sorrow.


