### Lenten Practices...

### Ash Wednesday: A day of fasting and abstinence

Lent is a time of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving in preparation for our celebrations of Easter, when Christ died and rose from the dead for our salvation. Ash Wednesday is also a day of fasting and abstinence.

There are two days of compulsory fasting and abstinence prescribed by the Church: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (Code of Canon Law #1251).

**Fasting** means eating less than normal. We are asked to eat one regular size meal and two smaller meals. Catholics between the ages of 16-60 are asked to abide by this discipline.

Abstinence means abstaining from eating meat on this day. Catholics older than 14 years of age are asked to abide by this discipline. Note: We are also encouraged to continue the traditional practice of abstaining from meat every Friday. As well, one should not engage in excessive entertainment throughout the Lenten Season, and most certainly not on Good Friday.

Women's Bible Study – Please join us for a look at the culture and society in the first century in the Middle East. In this captivating study, *Jesus and Women* by Kristi McLelland, we will be transported back to when Jesus was with us in the flesh. This study (feast) will begin with a time to chat about the homework that we completed throughout the week, an hour-long teaching video and then a chance to unpack the video. This 7-week program runs from Feb. 28 to April 11 (Tuesday evenings) from 7 to 9 pm in the St. John Room. 

### Earthquake Relief

On February 6th, parts of Turkey and Syria experienced a devastating earthquake. It is estimated that over 22,000 people have lost their lives and more than 77,000 reported injured. The earthquake has left both countries in a state of crisis that is made worse by exposure to aftershocks and winter storms.

CNEWA Catholic Near East Welfare Association – CNEWA has been a lifeline for the poor throughout the Middle East, Northeast Africa, India and Eastern Europe for 90 years.
